Important Information

- 1.) Students must complete 13 core course units and 3 elective course units to complete the program. Students are pre-registered for all of the core courses. Changes to students' schedules may be made by contacting the Registrar.
- 2.) All courses will be offered provided sufficient enrollment levels are met. In the event of the cancellation of a planned course, the Registrar will notify students of their schedule options.
- 3.) Electives may be taken earlier than scheduled, provided the elective pre-requisites have been met.
- 4.) A term is ten weeks in length with each course meeting once per week for 3.5 hours. Each 1 unit (10-week) class is equivalent to 4 quarter hours. Each .5 unit (5-week) class is equivalent to 2 quarter hours.
- 5.) Two-Week Self-Directed Online Pre-Assignment (5190, 5210, 5230) must be completed before week 3 of the session. Class will then meet from week 3 to week 10 of a term. Students will be notified via email when access to the self-directed course assignment is available. Instructors are available for questions.
- 6.) The summer term is optional. Summer courses meet twice per week for 3.5 hours and consist of a 5-week term. Some courses follow an alternative delivery schedule. Students receive email communications from the Registrar regarding all elective options and scheduling.
- 7.) Attendance Policy: Three absences in any ten week course, two absences in the eight week in-class portion of a course, or two absences in a five week course will result in the student's immediate withdrawal from the course. Students who miss class sessions as outlined above must petition the course dean for approval to remain in the course.
- 8.) The Lake Forest MBA offers 3 specializations: Global Management, Organizational Behavior and Healthcare Management (on-site locations only). It is recommended that students speak with the Registrar early in the program if they are interested in pursuing a specialization.
- 9) It is the student's responsibility to make sure all degree requirements are fulfilled for graduation. To complete the MBA program, students must complete 13 core units and 3 elective units.
