This networking event, held high above the city on the 66th floor of the Willis Tower, featured a dynamic presentation by Lynn Osmond. Osmond, President and CEO of the Chicago Architecture Foundation spoke about the development of commercial building projects throughout Chicago's history. Special thanks to the Membership Committee of the Metropolitan Club for hosting this event.

New Sustainability Elective Well Received

This summer Lake Forest Graduate School of Management offered for the first time the Sustainable Business course. Craig Raben (Hotchkiss Scholar, Class of 2003), Frank Brletich, Sr. Associate Dean, and Bruce Bendix, LFGSM Faculty member, designed and delivered the new course to 13 students who rated it 4.96/5.00. The summer course was delivered in an accelerated format and included a mixture of readings, discussion, project work, guest lecturers and a site visit.

Sustainability, defined broadly to include social equity, economic development, and environmental restoration, offers new opportunities (but also challenges) for business. 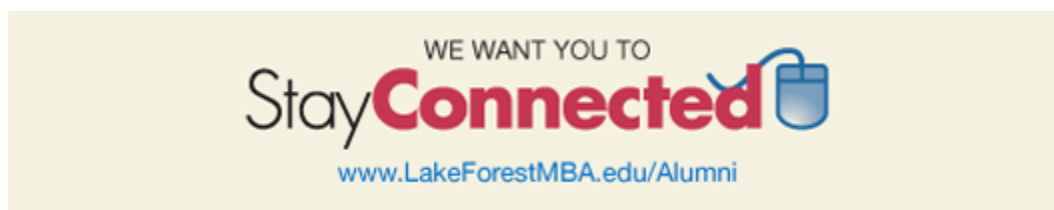
We Hear You!
